Correspondance between
the Consolidating (or Framework) Treaty and the Adaption Act (or Protocol)
December 2006**

The separation between Consolidating or Framework Treaty and Adaptation Act or Protocol would have no consequences as to the formal hierarchy between rules of primary law. As in the present situation and as in the Constitutional treaty the content of treaties, acts, protocols and annexes remain all of primary law, albeit they have a different value from a symbolic point of view

NB *The following document are only a very provisional exercise aimed at*

- *Clarifying what would be the content of the Consolidating (or Framework) Treaty and the Adaption Act (or Protocol);*
- *Showing how the content of the Constitutional Treaty is distributed between the Consolidating/Framework Treaty (the 'substance') and the Adaptation Act/Protocol('technicalities').*

This would need further elaboration, going into the content of some of the clauses of the Constitutional treaty of 2004 which would have to be divided between the Treaty and the Act.

It does not preclude the need of changing slightly the formulation of the Constitutional Treaty in order to adapt it to the split. This means mainly replacing the cross-references between articles of the Constitutional treaty.

It does not either preclude reformulations that could be the main task of the Intergovernmental conference.

It shows that the possible Interim Protocol and the Adaptation Act/protocol can be drafted in such a way as to bind the two final texts, and make sure that the Adaptation Act/protocol is only implementing the provisions of the Consolidating/Framework Treaty and does not become a pretext for a revision of the Consolidating/Framework Treaty.

The article on ratification and entry into force could be written as follows:

1. *This Treaty shall be ratified by the High Contracting Parties in accordance with their respective constitutional requirements. The instruments of ratification shall be deposited with the Government of the Italian Republic.*
2. *This Treaty shall enter into force on the first day of the second month following the deposit of the instrument of ratification by the last signatory State to take this step.*
3. *Those provisions of this treaty which cannot replace correspondending provisions of the Treaties establishing the European Community and on the European Union without further adaptations of these Treaties will become applicable with the entry into force of the Act adapting the Treaties establishing the European Community and on the European Union.*
4. *The High Contracting Parties take on with no further delay the necessary procedures for the ratification of this Treaty.*

The article on the Act of adaptation could be drafted as follows:

With the signature of this Treaty, an Intergovernmental Conference will assemble on the level of representatives of the foreign ministers, in order to propose the indispensable adaptations to the Treaty establishing the European Community and the Treaty on the European Union, in accordance with protocol number 2 annexed to this Treaty. Those proposals will be comprised in an Act adapting the Treaties establishing the European Community and on the European Union, which will be adopted and will enter into force according to Article 48 of the Treaty on the European Union.

An Interim Protocol on the adaptation of the Treaty establishing the European Community and the Treaty on the European Union could be drafted in order to ensure that the Intergovernmental Conference would accomplish its work in a short period of time and that it would take as basis for its work the Final Act of 29 October 2004, which includes the Treaty establishing a Constitution for Europe, as well the protocols and declarations annexed to it. The protocol would specify which provisions of the consolidation treaty replaced immediately the corresponding provisions in the Treaties of Rome and Maastricht, as adapted by the Treaty of Nice, and which provisions would become applicable only after the entry into force of the Act of adaptation.
