You are hereby charged with the responsibility to inform all members of PAK and Friends of PAK as follows:

"Andreas G. Papandreou, the leader of PAK, in a statement tonight stated that Senator McGovern's pronouncement as recorded in the National Herald of New York on August 28th, is completely unacceptable to the Greek people. He has argued falsely that the Greek junta is a friend of the Arab people and that, therefore, the 6th Fleet which has obtained home port facilities in Piraeus will not serve the interests of Israel. For this reason Senator McGovern is opposed to extending home port facilities to the 6th Fleet in Greece. Had the junta been openly pro-Israel, senator McGovern presumably would support the home-port facilities. Senator McGovern knows full well that the junta is an arm of U.S. imperialism and will execute whatever orders it receives from its masters, the Pentagon. It is essential, therefore, for the Greek people to understand that the American elections do not concern them. No matter who is elected to the Presidency, whether Nixon or McGovern, he will work for the consolidation and expansion of the American imperialist establishment and in the end, therefore, for the consolidation of the junta in Greece. The liberation of Greece can come about only as a result of the resistance of the Greek people, who should seek their allies among the peoples who are struggling against American imperialism in all its forms."
