International

Social Praxis is an international journal which welcomes contributions, dealing with social problems, from all parts of the world.

Interdisciplinary

Social Praxis is an interdisciplinary journal. Writers from various disciplines – including anthropology, sociology, and the natural sciences – are invited to bring their distinctive perspectives to bear on problems of general concern.

Language

Social Praxis will be published in English with summaries in French. In special cases French articles can be accepted. Book reviews, comments and rejoinders are also accepted. Books for review and all editorial correspondence should be sent to the Editor.

Contributions

Contributions should be typewritten, double-spaced and with footnotes numbered consecutively at the end. Three copies with a brief summary should be submitted.

Criteria for papers

Social Praxis places no rigid restrictions on the length and format of papers. Quality and clarity are the main criteria guiding our selection. Submitted papers will be read by at least two members of the board, nevertheless we strive to give quick decisions.

Special issues

Social Praxis will publish special issues devoted to specific topics. Two issues are in preparation: *Imperialism and Dependence in Latin America* to be edited by Theotonio Dos Santos and *Alienation and the Ways of Overcoming it in the Modern World* to be edited by Adam Schaff.
