Policy Network 'Global Europe – Social Europe' Symposium

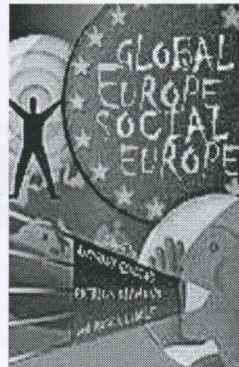
Brussels, 5 December 2006

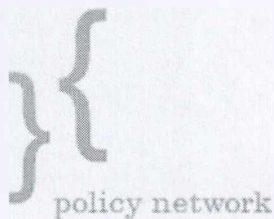

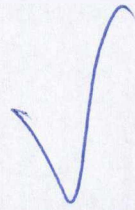
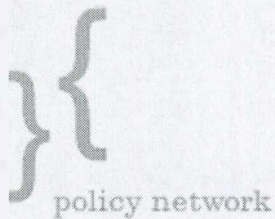
